#### GANNAWARRA REFLECTIONS—One Year On video

To acknowledge 12 months on from the October-December 2022 floods, Council and Northern District Community Health produced a video featuring residents who helped develop the original seven-video Gannawarra Reflections series. The new video provides an update on recovery one year on from the flood event. #### DECEMBER 2023 AND JANUARY 2024 STORMS AND FLASH FLOODING EVENTS

Gannawarra, like many other areas across the state, has been significantly impacted by three storm events between Christmas Eve 2023 and 7-8 January 2024. Over this two week period 200 and 300mm of rainfall was received. By comparison, the average annual rainfall for Gannawarra is approximately 375mm.

These three significant rainfall events, and subsequent flash-flooding, have caused widespread damage across our municipality.

Farmers can also contact AgVic on 0427 694 185 or recovery@agriculture.vic.gov.au for agriculture recovery assistance or advice, including technical support.

Emergency management authorities are monitoring increased flows into Ghow (Kow) Swamp following flooding that impacted Central Victoria on 7-8 January 2024. Council encourages the community to stay informed, and to reach out for accurate information and assistance from the relevant authorities as required.

Residents can stay up to date with emergency warnings and road closures by relying on these trusted sources:

- The Bureau of Meteorology website (www.bom.gov.au) and app;
- The Victoria State Emergency Service website (www.ses.vic.gov.au); and

RECOVERY GRANTS FINAL CLAIM DATE EXTENDED

PRIMARY PRODUCER FLOOD

The final claim date for applicants who successfully applied for a Primary Producer Flood Recovery grant for the October 2022 floods and storms has been extended from 13 January 2024 to 31 May 2024.

This date extension applies to successful applicants of the:

- Primary Producer Flood Recovery Grant.
- Rural Landholder Grant.
- Transport Support Program.

This extension provides primary producers and rural landholders additional time to undertake their recovery activities and finalise their claims for Tier 2 payments.

While an extension has been provided, grant recipients are encouraged to make their reimbursement claims as soon as possible.

Rural Finance administer these programs on behalf of the Victorian and Commonwealth Governments.
