ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS

A reminder to residents that renewal of dog and cat registration is due on 10 April. Animal owners will be receiving renewals in the mail soon. Reminder for new animals that proof of microchipping is required. If claiming a concession (aged animal, working dog, sterilised etc./pensioner concession) proof documentation is required.

DECLARATION OF BOATING EXEMPTION

For the purpose of boating activity by Ski Racing Victoria, all vessels and masters participating in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score 4 event are exempt from the waterway rules as they apply to the waters established as an event exclusion zone on the water of Lake Charm. Full details of the exemptions from waterway rules for Lake Charm, who they apply to and the conditions are available at www.gsc.vic.gov.au

An exclusion zone will be in place from 6.00am to 6.00pm on Saturday 24 March and 6.00am to 6.00pm on Sunday 25 March 2018 for the waters of Lake Charm. Only vessels and masters participating in the Ski Racing Victoria Point Score 4 event are permitted in the exclusion zone.
