2023 COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM APPLICATIONS

Applications for Council's 2023 Community Grants Program will open on Tuesday, 1 August and will be accepted up to 4pm Thursday, 31 August.

As part of Council's 2023/24 Budget, \$80,000 has been allocated to support the program's two streams:

- **Community Event:** Up to \$5,000 per application to support local events.
- **Community Support:** Up to \$5,000 per application to support local projects and activities.

Successful projects need to align with the *Growing Gannawarra – 2021-2025 Council Plan* and/or other Council strategies which will contribute to the Gannawarra and support our community's long-term vision.
