ACCESSIBILITY PARKING PERMITS

VicRoads' Accessibility Parking Permit Scheme is replacing the Disability Parking Permit, and aims to standardise permits to better align with the Australian Disability Parking Scheme. As part of these changes, applications for new Accessible Parking Permits need to be completed online via a VicRoads portal, which is available at www.gsc.vic.gov.au/parking. Residents who need assistance to complete an application are welcome to visit either the Cohuna or Kerang Customer Service Centre's, where our friendly staff are able to help. Residents who currently hold a Disability Parking Permit may continue to do so until their current permit expires.
